OUR HISTORY

The Foundation began in 2003 as the charitable arm of Kids Behavioral Health (KBH), a corporation providing residential and day treatment programs for troubled youth. Dr. Earl Nielsen, our Founder, was then on the board of KBH. He and Bill Vickers, our initial benefactor, realized, although they were helping some children, there were many more unable to take advantage of the services KBH had to offer. Indeed, these children did not have the means to meet any of their critical needs. With this realization, For Kids Foundation was born.

Serving as a safety net for children who fall through the cracks, For Kids Foundation provides one-time funding for the unmet needs of Northern Nevada children (from birth to age 21) when there is no other known resource available.

Provide or align resources to help every child thrive.









- In-kind donations of products from local businesses totaled **\$11,317**.









LIVES CHANGED IN 2024

416 APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE RECEIVED



Twenty-one percent of 2024 applications were focused on the **mental health** of our youth, including consultations, neuropsychological testing, psychiatric hospitalizations, prescription medication, talk therapy and equine-assisted therapy.

Thirty applications received requested help paying for **dance**, **karate**, **gymnastics**, and other **group sport activities**, offering at-risk youth a positive experience, healthy physical activity and opportunity to build self esteem.





We received **23** applicants for **dental** care and **17** applications for **orthodontia**, deemed urgent and necessary for the physical and mental health and wellbeing of at-risk youth.

We approved funding for families with children facing ambulatory disabilities, covering out-of-pocket costs for **adaptive devices** to aid mobility and enhance family participation after insurance.





We received **72** requests for **beds/bedding** for at-risk children or children living in multigenerational households who did not have a safe and proper bed for a good night's rest to set them up for success in their daily lives.

NEVADA STATISTICS

FOR KIDS FOUNDATION ADDRESSES THE HEALTH. WELLBEING AND EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF NORTHERN NEVADA CHILDREN



Population: Nevada's 2023 population is estimated at 3,194,176; 21.5% under age 18; 5.4% under age 5 and 12.5% living in poverty (U.S. Census Bureau).

Health: 8% of Nevada's children under age 19 are uninsured (Annie E. Casey Foundation/Kids Count).





Education: According to edweek.org, Nevada receives an overall national grade of C- in "Chance for Success."

Mental Health: 1 in 5 young people, between the ages 13 and 18, has or will develop a mental health need in their lifetime (Nevada PEP).



Thousands of children have found assistance through our Program, with more than \$1.7M Program Awards paid out since 2010.
